- Carry 186 Kits to Annual Conference this year, 106 School Kits, 50 Health Kits, and 30 Layette Kits.
- Feed the homeless each 5th Tuesday at Greater Mount Moriah Church. Our next opportunity to serve is July 31, 2018.
- Give support to help with disaster relief through the United Methodist Committee of Relief (UMCOR), help the persecuted church through the Voice of the Martyrs, help those who are hungry in our local community through eastern Henrico FISH and Varina Episcopal Food Pantry, and distribute God's Word through the Gideons.
- See the number of young adults and children increase in our weekly services and see the strong work God is beginning to do through our Children's Church.
- Serve cooperatively, with the churches in our community. Our next big event: Vacation Bible School with Four Mile Creek Baptist Church, August 3-5th.
- We are welcoming a new Pastor July 1st to our church.
